The Virginia Transition Assistance Program (VTAP) – offers transitioning service members and their spouses the best Virginia has to offer. By providing peer-to-peer support through the transition process, VTAP works alongside the transitioning service member or spouse to make referrals that address specific needs.

The Virginia Department of Veterans Services (DVS) - advocates for Virginia veterans and connects them to earned benefits and services they have earned.
